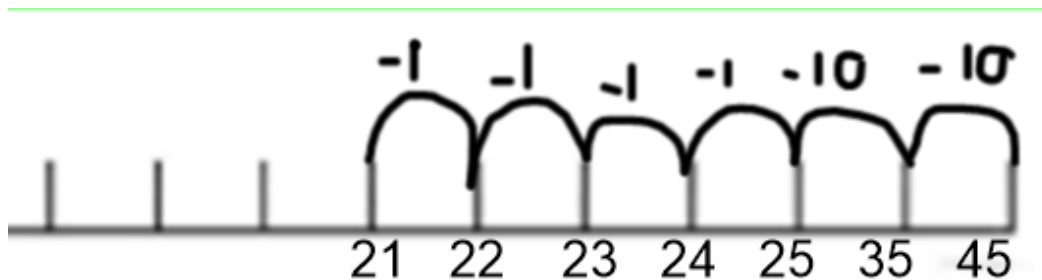

MLJ is to subtract using partitioning two two-digit numbers

Remember in our lesson we used the blank number lines to count back in tens and ones - see if you can have a go! Here is an example to help you remember what to do.

$$45 - 24 = 21$$
