$489 - 36 =$


$327 - 119 =$

$456 - 243 =$

Solve the word problems using an appropriate subtraction method:

1. Jay has a collection of 263 football cards. Alex has a collection of 162 football cards. How many more cards does Jay have?
2. John is driving to *Glasgow*. His journey is 623 miles. He stopped after 132 miles and again after travelling another 87 miles. How much further does he have to travel to get to *Glasgow*.
3. A pack of Christmas cards costs 99p. How much change would I get from £5.

Here is a subtraction.

 $487 - 50 = 482$

What mistake has been made?

Here is a calculation with three missing digits.

$726 + _0 - _0 = 7_6$

All the missing digits are different.

What could the calculation be?

How many calculations can you find?
