Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning:

- To see themselves as a valuable individual

We will be learning:

Writing:

- Write some Phase 2 and 3 'hard to spell' words
- Independently writing labels and words
- Write short sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops

Reading:

- Read Phase 2 and 3 'hard to read' words
- Independently reading CVC words containing phonemes and diagraphs
- Reading sentences with some fluency
