

Steps to Success:

1. Choose either short multiplication (if you have a 1-digit number) or grid method (for 2-digit numbers)
2. Set out the calculation carefully
3. Estimate (round to nearest whole)
4. Calculate (use known number facts)

1. $£2.76 \times 6 =$ (use short method)
2. $£13.22 \times 3 =$ (use short method)
3. $£9.45 \times 8 =$ (use short method)
4. $£25.20 \times 22 =$ (use grid method)
