

Steps to Success:

1. Choose either short multiplication (if you have a 1-digit number) or grid method (for 2-digit numbers)
2. Set out the calculation carefully
3. Estimate (round to nearest whole)
4. Calculate (use known number facts)

1. $£175.68 \times 4 =$

2. $£42.30 \times 25 =$

3. $£92.60 \times 34 =$
