Maths = 4 points



Log on to Mathletics

Topic (History and Geography) = 3 points

Draw, shade and label a map of Scandinavia including the capital cities. Then write a fact page about Scandinavia including: and introduction, a sub-heading of each country with a paragraph about each country. Include information about features such as mountains, seas and climate.

Science = 2 points

Create a series of 'fossils' showing how a particular feature of an animal has changed over time (like in the horse example). Draw your series of fossils in a table clearly showing how the bone/tooth has changed.

Practise spelling your 10 words

Now record a sentence for each of your 10 words

English (Descriptive Writing) = 3 points

Write a suspense paragraph about a setting of your choice. Remember to include: short punchy sentences, scary description, repetition, personification, hide the scary thing, Use one word sentences, Use powerful verbs, add a simile, add the character's description, use ellipsis, put an adverb at the beginning of a sentence.
