Read daily (4x per wk)  
 Ensure that you know all the meanings of the words in your books and record them in your reading record. I will be asking you to share the amazing vocabulary you find.

Maths = 3 points

## MATHLETICS

Play live mathletics twice a week. Make sure you choose a level that is challenging and try to progress to at least the next level by Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2024.

Topic (History and Geography) = 4 points

## Ancient Egypt

Make a travel brochure about Ancient Egypt. Think about the key places you would encourage people to visit, what they should look at and who they might meet. Use pictures with lots of facts and information. Remember - the purpose of a brochure is to persuade.

Science = 3 points

## How does light create shadows?

Experiment and see how light creates shadows. Take photographs or draw pictures of these objects with the light shining from 3 different angles. How does this change the shadow? What happens when you move the light source (or object) closer or further away?

Phonics/Spellings = 2 points

## Words with a hyphen.

Explore words with a hyphen. E.g. co-ordinate, re-tell.

Find 5 words with the co- prefix which need a hyphen.

Find 5 words with the re- prefix which need a hyphen.

Challenge: Can you find any other words with a prefix which sometimes needs a hyphen? Record these.

DT (Sewing) = 2 points

Using our design and making skills learnt during 'mobile phone cases', to design and create a picture or Christmas tree decoration. You should include:

1. A design criteria
2. An innovative design which has been annotated
3. Use the different stitches learnt
