Attendance

The Department for Education (DfE) expects children to be in school every day so they don't miss out on important learning. For this reason, holidays during term time are not allowed unless there are very exceptional circumstances. A family holiday isn't normally seen as exceptional, so it's unlikely to be authorised.

If you do need to request time off, you must apply to the school in advance, and the headteacher will look at your request carefully. Every case is considered individually.

When children miss school, they can fall behind in their learning, lose confidence, and find it harder to keep up with their classmates. Good attendance also helps them build strong routines and friendships.

If leave is taken without permission, the school has to record it as unauthorised. In these cases, the local authority may issue a fixed penalty notice (a fine). At the moment, this is £60 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days, rising to £120 if paid within 28 days. If not paid, the matter could go to court.

To give children the very best chance to succeed, we ask families to plan holidays outside of school term dates wherever possible.

Book Fair

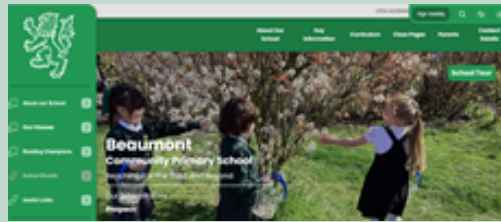
A huge thank you to all that supported our Scholastic book fair this week! It was great to see how excited the children were to explore the books!
